Film and Fashion Insiders Mingle at International Make-Up Show

Vogue make-up artist Mary Greenwell, movie make-up artists Mike Elizalde and Morag Ross and *Hellboy 2* actor Doug Jones (Abe Sapien) are some of the people you'll meet at the 2009 International Make-Up Artist Trade Show, held Jan. 24-25 at London's Alexandra Palace.

IMATS spotlights film and fashion make-up and features celebrity make-up artists, classes, live demonstrations, shopping opportunities and an exciting student competition.

The event is open to professionals and the public.

Greenwell has worked for international editions of

Vogue; her celebrity clientele has

included Princess Diana, Uma Thurman, Gwyneth Paltrow, Kate Winslet, Keira Knightley, Kate Moss and Gisele Bündchen.

Additional keynote speakers include movie make-up specialists Morag Ross and Mike Elizalde. Ross is a BAFTA award winner whose filmography includes *I'm Not There*, *Indiana Jones and the Kingdom of the Crystal Skull*, *The Aviator*, *Lost In Translation* and *Elizabeth: The Golden Age*.

Elizalde, a Los Angeles-based make-up designer, sculptor and animatronic engineer, has worked on more than 45 feature films, including *Men in Black*, *A.I. Artificial Intelligence*, *Fantastic Four* and *X-Men: The Last Stand*. Most recently, he worked on *Hellboy 2*; he will participate in a *Hellboy 2* panel discussion featuring actor Doug Jones and many of the make-up artists and creature creators.

IMATS also features an exhibitor hall, where cosmetics companies will show and sell products; make-up classes and demonstrations by industry leaders; the Make-Up Museum and the student make-up competition, which is divided into beauty and character categories. This year's beauty competition has a gothic theme; the character competition has an *X-Men* mutants theme. Students will race against the clock to create winning looks.

Make-Up Artist magazine is read in 50 countries around the world and was created in 1996 by Emmy® Award-winning make-up artist Michael Key.

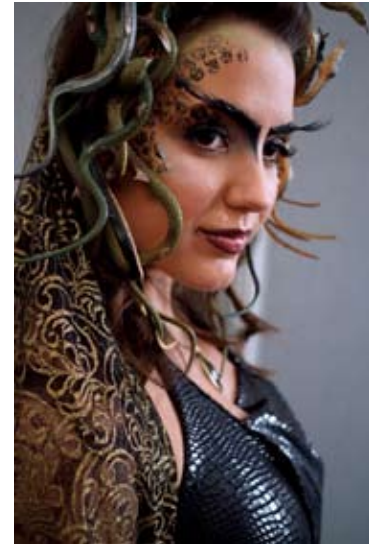
